SCHOOL MEALS

The new menu for next term is also attached to today's newsletter email (and will also be on the website on the newsletters page).

To qualify for free school meals you must fulfil one of the following criteria:

- Universal Credit, provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods (£616.67 per month);
- Income Support;
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance;
- Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999;
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are also not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual household gross income that does not exceed £16,190 (as assessed by HMRC); or
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

If you meet this criteria please ask for an application form (or complete online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/free-school-meals) even if your child currently receives a free meal in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2.
