REMINDERS

- **Early Arrivals** - Just a reminder that children should not arrive at school before 8.35am unless you are with them. They are not supervised before this time and we cannot ensure their safety. Children should arrive between 8.35-8.40am ready for the start of the day.
- **Headlice** - _Please can we remind you to check your child/children's heads each day – we seem to have an epidemic of head lice in school once again. Thank you.
- **Mobile Phones** – Please can we remind everyone that if you take photos on your mobile phone of any displays etc in school that feature children the photos **must not be uploaded to any social media network sites**.
- **Parking** – Please can we remind you to help keep the layby outside of school clear of cars – we have several visits planned during the rest of this term and will have coaches returning children to school and they need to park in the layby. This should be kept clear at all times along with the areas between the yellow zig zags. These measures are in place to help keep you child/children safe. Thank you.
- **Sun safety** – To ensure children remain protected from the effects of over exposure to the sun (especially at lunchtimes) **please can you make sure your child brings a peaked cap into school with their name written inside**. If you wish your child to wear sun protection cream please can these bottles/tubes also have names written clearly on them. We will encourage children to wear their hats and to apply their own cream/lotion when necessary. Even though the weather is getting a little warmer children still need to bring a coat/jacket to school each day. The day may be fine and warm on a morning but by lunchtime the weather can change and children still need an extra layer.
- **Uniform** - Now that the warmer weather has arrived children can wear either short school trousers or summer dresses. However please could we ask that girls skirts remain at an acceptable length for school.
