Please can we remind parents and carers to show consideration for our neighbours on Noels Court and Mowbray Road when dropping off and collecting your child by car. The parking bays outside the Sheltered Housing should not be used as access to these is needed throughout the day by care professionals visiting the residents.

We have received a number of complaints and concerns regarding the inconvenience caused to our neighbours and the potential dangers to the children caused by the volume of cars outside at the start and end of the school day. We would ask parents/carers to

consider other options where possible such as walking to school or parking a little further away from the school and walking the last bit as this may help the congestion outside the school and reduce the dangers to children arriving and leaving school.

The Community Police Officer PCSO Diane Smith has also been alerted to the problem and she will be making regular patrols in the coming weeks

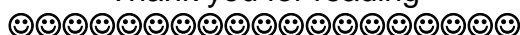
