Lost Property



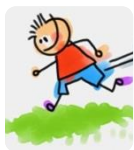

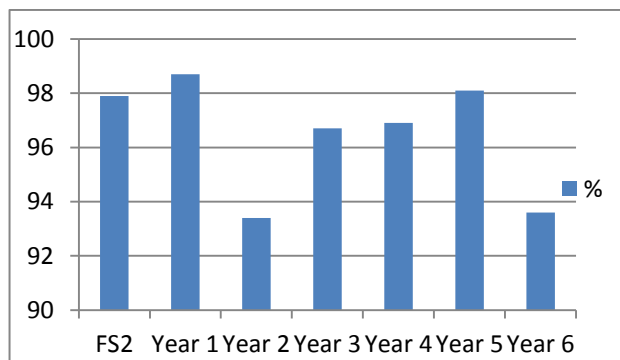
Sports Day
