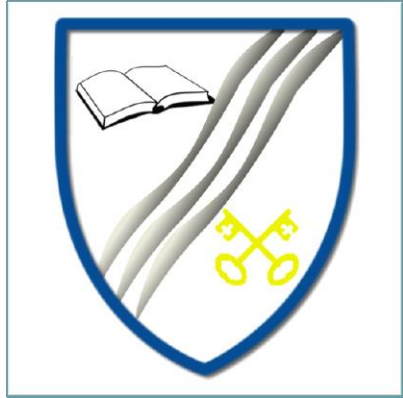
Please note due to the parents consultation evenings on Wednesday and Thursday the following Clubs will not be running:

(Wednesday) and **Multiskills** (Thursday) will both still go ahead.



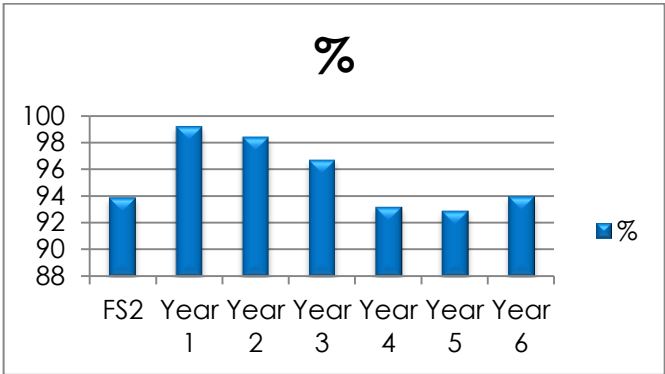
The Hangout – Emergency Contact Number
