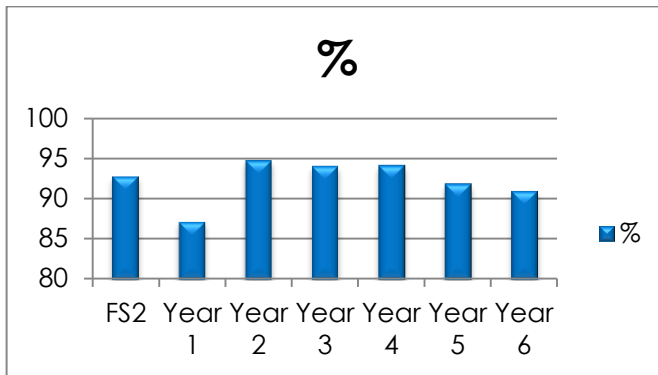
#### Mobile Phones
