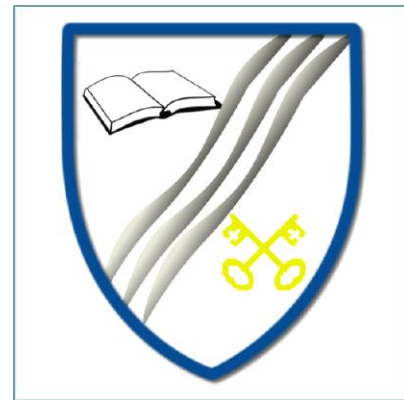
Welcome Wednesday

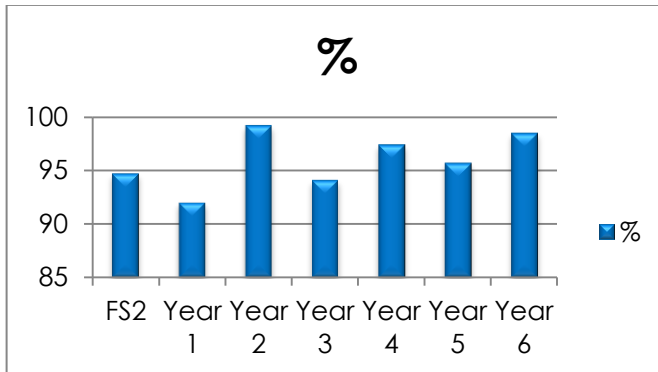
Monday – Friday during term time
