

## Year 4 Weekly SPaG Practice

This work should take around 10 minutes to complete each day. Please revisit the rules and read them (any questions please don't hesitate to ask) and then complete the task below. We normally only do SPaG Monday-Thursday and our spelling test on Friday is our SPaG focus for Friday.

Our SPaG rule that we will be focusing on this week is:

### **Pronouns**

#### **Monday- 'Talky SPaG' (you do not need to record anything for this lesson- it is just a discussion about the rule)**

Pronouns are words that we use instead of repeating the noun. For example instead of saying:

*Miss Cable ate her sandwich because Miss Cable was hungry.*

You would use a pronoun and say:

*Miss Cable ate her sandwich because she was hungry.*

Pronouns can also be possessive to tell you something has been owned by someone e.g.

*That is my bag!*
