#### Children's Worship Team Session Sunday 8th Dec 1600 - 17.30 at St Anne's Church


An introductory workshop for young people (age 6+) interested in creating and leading worship at St Anne's Catterick or Holy Trinity, Tunstall.

Would you like to create and lead prayers in church? Tell the stories of our faith? Help other people grow closer to God? This introductory session on leading worship might just be for you!

Young people already help to lead worship as part of the Collective Worship Team at Michael Syddall School and at Holy Trinity, Tunstall. So now we're taking the next step and exploring setting up a Children's Worship Team to help create and lead worship at St Anne's Church Catterick (and Holy Trinity Tunstall). Rev'd Lindsay Southern (who taught in primary and secondary schools before becoming a vicar and trains adults to lead worship) and Neil Southern (a qualified and experienced primary school teaching assistant) will be holding an introductory session for any children and young people interested (aged above 6 yrs old) on Sunday 8th December starting 4pm at St Anne's Church. Try your hand at some interactive worship activities and see if it's for you. ## **Drop off & Collection**

Children should arrive at school promptly on a morning, the school day starts at 8:45am, if your child arrives late they will receive a late mark in the register & they will be missing valuable learning time. All children enter school via their cloakroom door.

If children are late they will make their own way to class or be accompanied by a member of staff, parents will not be permitted to take children through school.
