Drop off & Collection

Children should arrive at school promptly on a morning, for FS & KS1 this is 8:45am & KS2 from 8:35am. All children enter school via their cloakroom door, with the exception year 4 who use the class fire door.

Children should not be entering school via the office unless they are late (gates close at 9am to allow time for parents/carers to leave



the school site). If children are late they will make their own way to class or be accompanied by a member of staff, parents will not be permitted to take children through school.

At the end of the day all children should be collected from their own classrooms, unless they have permission to walk home. Teachers will wait to give parents chance to get to more than one classroom if they have siblings to collect.

If children are in The Hangout parents should collect children and leave via The Hangout external door.

Parents should not be walking around inside school at anytime for Health & Safety/Safeguarding reasons.

It is not permitted on play on any of the school play equipment outside of school hours.

Do not let children climb on the fences at the front of school, the boulder near the KS1 entrance & other decorative features around the school premises.

It has also been brought to our attention that people are smoking directly outside school, as a smoke free site & trying to promote a healthy lifestyle we would like to ask that you do not smoke/vape on or in front of the school grounds.

Rev Lindsay has asked us to share that St Anne's Harvest service will be held this Sunday at 10:30am - a poster with details is in the lobby window.

Please be aware that we have people in school who suffer nut allergies. Please can parents be conscious of this when providing packed lunches and snacks.

Children should only be wearing stud earrings in school

For PE they should remove earrings where possible, if they are not able to remove them it is the responsibility of parents/carers to send in tape so the child can cover them themselves. Staff are not allowed to remove the earrings or apply/

remove tape.


