Important Message from NYCC re Social Networking

Parents of children in North Yorkshire Schools are increasingly using social networking sites such as Facebook to talk to their friends. Sometimes parents have used these sites to criticize or make inappropriate comments about schools or even individual teachers. Making defamatory comments on the internet has exactly the same legal consequences as if they are made directly to someone else. Legal action could be taken against the person who has made the online comment. Similarly threats of violence can lead to criminal proceedings under the Malicious Communications Act 1988.

If you have any concerns about anything which happens in school please speak to your child's class teacher in the first instance who will do their best to resolve things. If you are still unhappy we have a complaints procedure which will ensure that your concerns are investigated thoroughly and appropriate action taken.

Drop off & Collection

Children should arrive at school promptly on a morning, the school day starts at 8:45am, if your child arrives late they will receive a late mark in the register & they will be missing valuable learning time. All children enter school via their cloakroom door.

Children should not be entering school via the office unless they are late (gates close at 9am to allow time for parents/carers to leave the school site). If children are late they will make their own way to class or be accompanied by a member of staff, parents will not be permitted to take children through school.

Key Stage 2 children (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) can enter school from 8.35am. Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 children enter school at 8.45am. School ends at 3pm.

If your child is going to be absent from school please leave an absence voicemail before 8:45am or send a text using the School Present Gateway. We have to record reasons for absence on the register, any absences not explained will be recorded as unauthorised.
