

IMPORTANT: SCHOOL GATEWAY

We sent home a letter last week to inform you that as of 1st October we will no longer be accepting bookings via the office. We have increased the numbers for The Hangout slightly to accommodate when children go to other clubs,

We will also be using the system to email home letters and to request consent for trips/events which take place during the school day.


