Children should only be wearing stud earrings in school

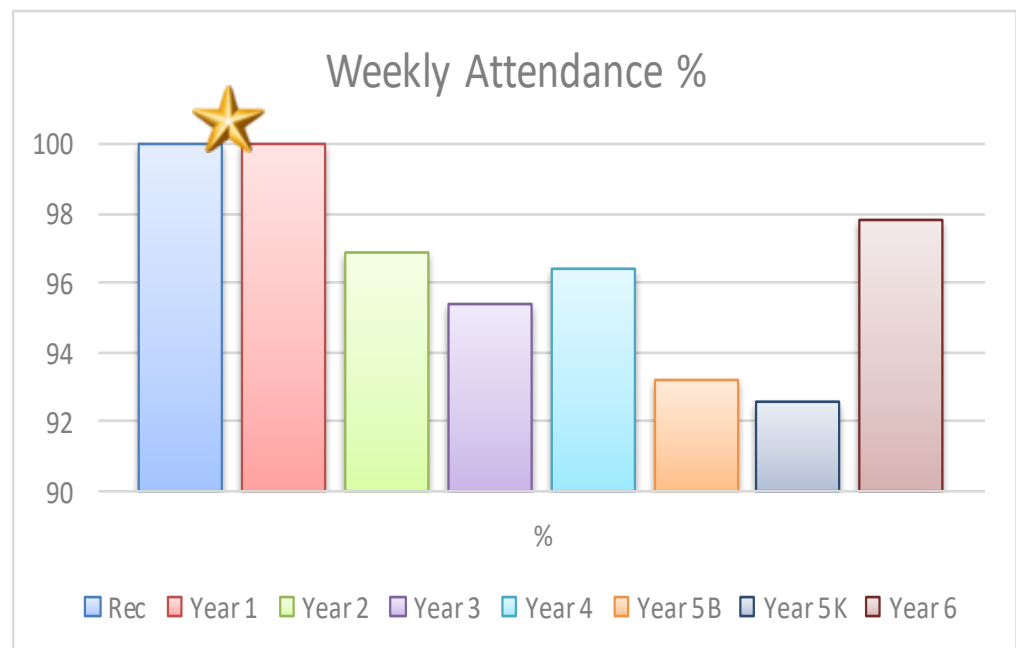
