Covid-19

We really want to thank everyone for their continued patience and understanding with how the ongoing pandemic impacts on school, all the pupils and you as families. We really appreciate and accept that some of the rules don't seem logical but as a school we have no choice but to follow guidance from the DFE and Government.

We too are fed up of the rules, for example we don't understand if a positive case within a class/household, pupils and other household members can go to work and school.

We also know it is hard to distinguish between a cold and Covid-19, but we are not medical professionals either and just trying to use our common sense but adhering to Government guidance too. If your child has got symptoms, they need to have a PCR (lateral flow test not acceptable if your child has symptoms) and they must isolate until you have negative result.

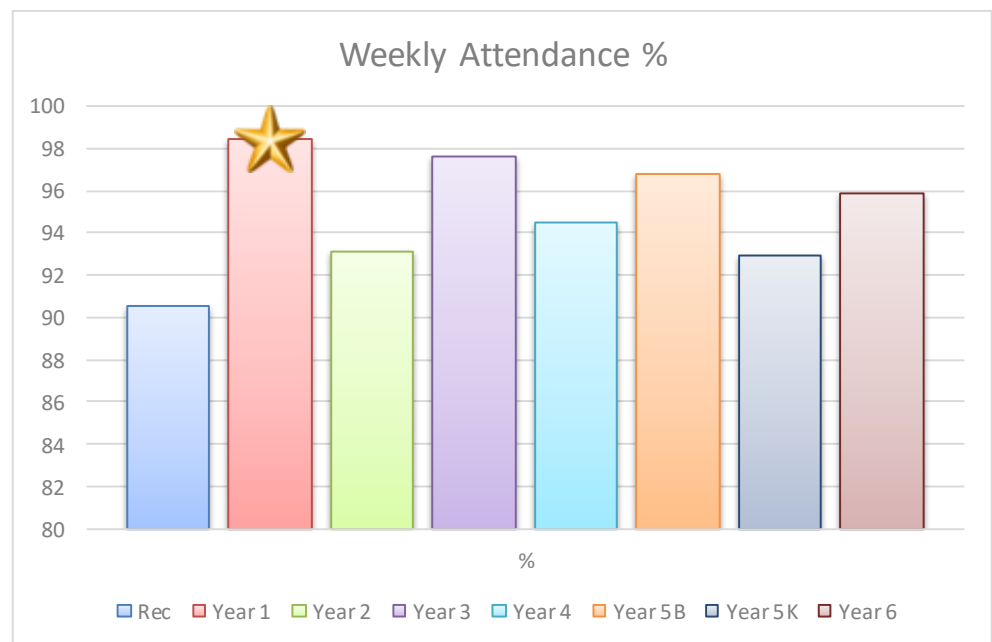
