AWARDS

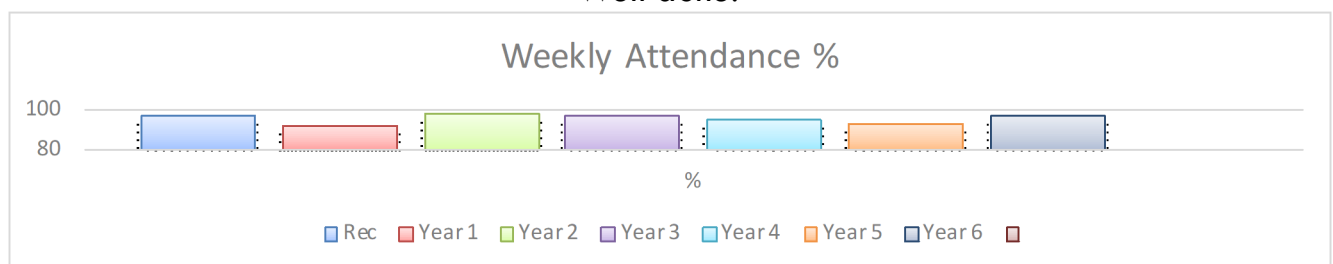
