You may be asked to bring in packed lunches for your child, if accounts are in arrears.



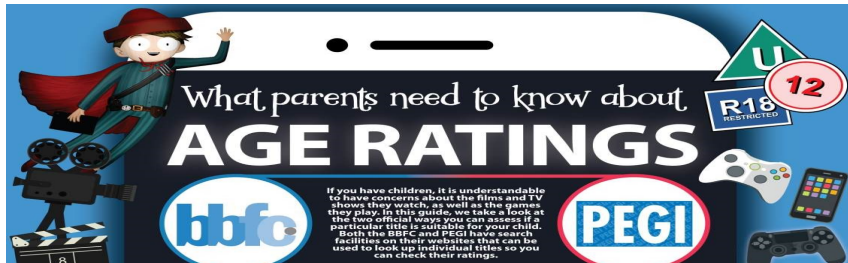

Each week awards are given out based on our six values. *Determination, Respect, Self*

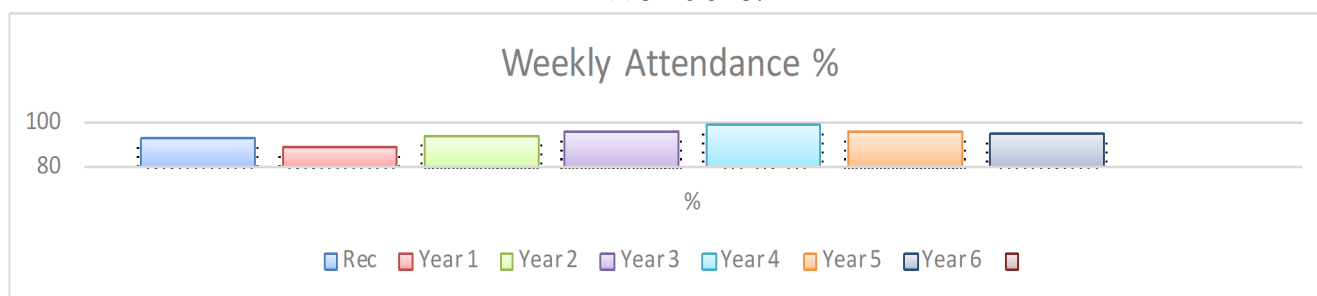
