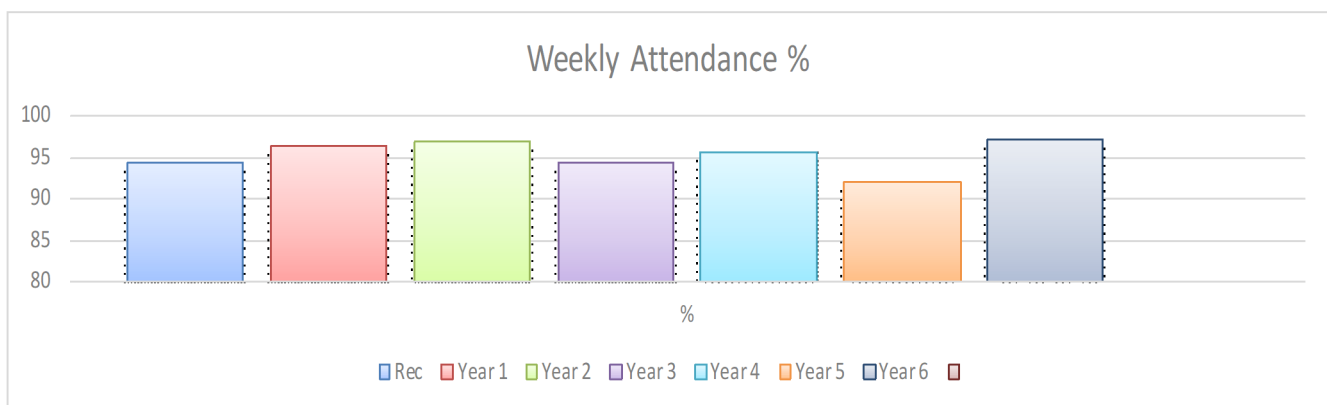
Each week awards are given out based on our six values. *Determination, Respect, Self-Belief, Teamwork, Honesty, Passion.*
