Each class will be making something using recycled items if you have anything from the list attached to the email please drop off at the school office before Monday 22nd April.

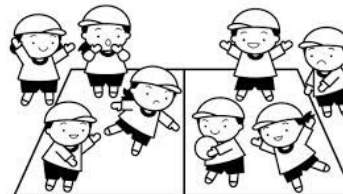

AWARDS

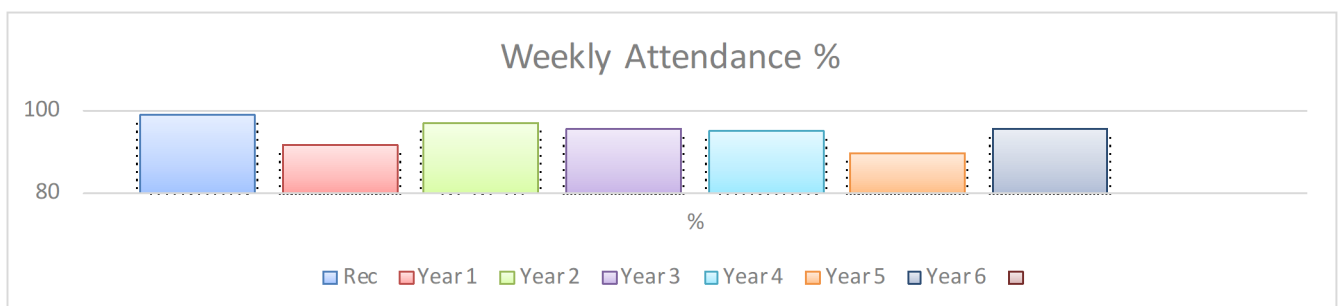
Each week awards are given out based on our six values. *Determination, Respect, Self-Belief, Teamwork, Honesty, Passion.*
