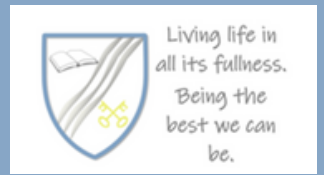

Get ready for FEAST: Free holiday activities and meals this Summer for eligible families

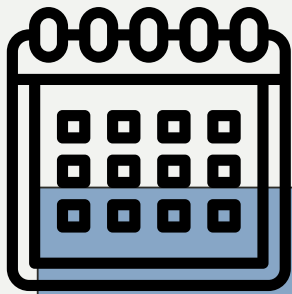
