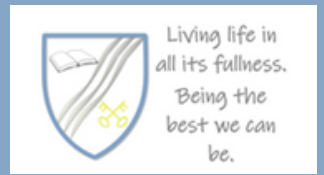

There will be **no** after school clubs (hangout open as normal) week commencing **15th July OR 2nd September**.

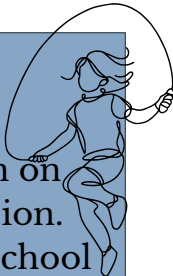
Hangout bookings for the first week back after summer will go live on **Thursday 18th July at 8pm**.

We have Dave with us again on Monday for a Skip2bfit session. Please can children come to school in their PE kits and a water bottle.

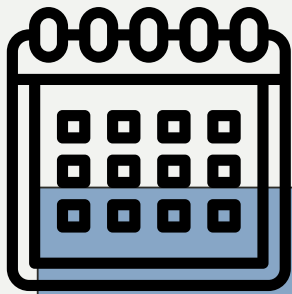


## Safeguarding Children in Our School

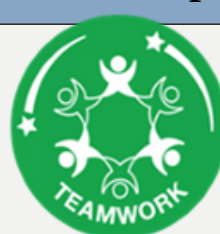

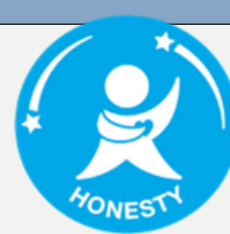
