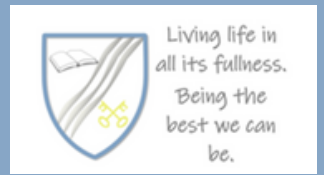

## Skipping Festival

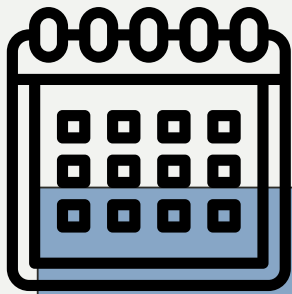

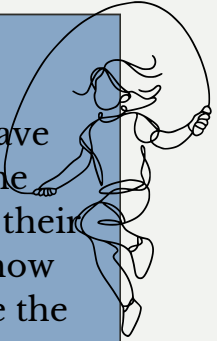
